

BYSTANDER INTERVENTION

Bystander Intervention is when a witness to a crime or possible crime, intervenes, rather than idly standing by.

The 5 D's: Direct | Distract | Delegate | Document | Delay

Notice the Event

Pay attention to what's happening around you



Interpret it as a Problem

Don't be side-tracked by ambiguity. If you think there may be a possible harassment, investigate further



Assume Personal Responsibility

Don't assume someone else will step in



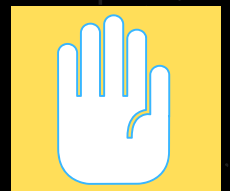
Know How to Help

Don't put yourself in harm's way, but do something directly or indirectly to prevent the act

Do something to intervene

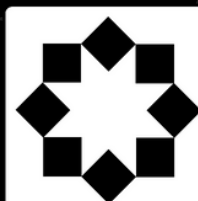
