



Call out for Creative Practitioners to Deliver Online Community Workshops

CLOSING DATE FOR APPLICATIONS: NOVEMBER 26th 10am

Amina MWRC is looking for Creative Practitioners to join our latest project:

Emerging Futures: Life in the Time of a Pandemic #NarrateCreateElevate

Creative Practitioners will be required to deliver a series of online workshops via Zoom, supported by the Emerging Futures Development Officer, to help participants develop their lockdown experiences into a variety of shareable digital artworks (eg. short films, audio works, poems, photography). Once the workshop series concludes there will be time for the Creative Practitioners to complete any further editing required to make the works ready for publishing. Applicants should have demonstrable experience of delivering creative workshops, preferably online, and be confident working in a multi-cultural environment.

Timeline: Workshops will be scheduled in consultation with Creative Practitioners but due to the circumstances of the participants, a degree of flexibility will be required. Workshops will last between 2 and 3 hours and take place in December 2020 and January 2021. Final works must be completed no later than Feb 21st 2021.

Fees: Workshops will be paid at £50 per hour (inclusive of prep time). Further editing work will be paid at £250 per day for a maximum of 2 full days.
