25 hours per week

Salary: £25,530 per annum pro rata (35 hours FTE)

Fixed term until Sept 2021 (likely to be extended, subject to further funding)

The post holder will build on and deliver our campaign message 'You Can Change This' to end VAWG.

The post will entail:

- delivering training to organisations and communities, to Amina staff and volunteers
- deliver workshops to Muslim/minority ethnic men's groups across Scotland to end VAWG
- self-care workshops for women who have experienced VAWG
- using creative mediums such as film, art and theatre to challenge VAWG

The post holder will be motivated and passionate about working with Muslim/minority ethnic women, have a flexible and adaptable approach to work and willingness to travel throughout Scotland

This post will initially be home working for Glasgow based candidates during COVID. If successful candidate is based elsewhere in Scotland, the role will be based and managed remotely.
